

Issaquah Vision Contact Lens Policy

Contact lenses are **FDA regulated** medical devices placed directly on the eye- one of our most precious organs. Establishing a proper fit is essential not only to assure excellent sight, but also to **protect the health of the eye.**

During your comprehensive exam, there is an additional charge for the testing and time required to achieve an optimum fit and the best visual acuity with your contact lenses. This is called a Contact Lens Evaluation. Additional testing may include corneal topography, slit-lamp examination using fluorescein dye, tear film testing, and slit-lamp examination of contact lens surfaces and alignment.

Contact Lens Evaluation Fees

This level of service is for patients already wearing contact lenses who require **NO CHANGE** in contact lens design for the best health and vision. These fees also apply to follow up visits outside of the global periods discussed in the next section.

Soft spherical: \$50

Soft toric: \$65

Soft multifocal or monovision: \$87

Rigid gas permeable or Keratoconus: \$87

Contact Lens Refit Fees with 90 day global period (Existing Wearers)

This is for patients trying a new contact lens design who may require follow-up visits to achieve the best fit and vision. *These fees include follow up visits during a 90 day period. The global fee is in addition to the initial evaluation fee.*

Contact Lens Evaluation Fees with 90 day global period (First Time (New) Wearer)

The first time (new) wearer fees are for patients who have not previously worn contact lenses. These patients will be provided with personalized training in insertion and removal of the contact lenses, including safety and care instructions. *These fees include the initial evaluation, and all follow up visits during a 90 day period.*

Level 1 Basic: \$75 (refit)/ \$125 (new)

-Soft spherical

Level 2 Advanced: \$125 (refit)/ \$185 (new)

-Soft toric (corrects astigmatism) or spherical rigid gas permeable

Level 3 Specialized: \$175 (refit)/ \$250 (new)

-Soft multifocal or monovision (corrects near vision for presbyopia)

Level 4 Complex: \$250-\$500 (refit)/ \$330-\$500 (new)

-Multifocal rigid gas permeable, keratoconus, Synergeyes, post-surgical cornea, significant corneal disease

Many insurance companies do not cover contact lens evaluation or fitting fees. Please feel free to ask us if you have any questions about our fees.
